As the Tutor/Lecturer it was my responsibility to write the courses or lectures most appropriately suited to the student body in each case. Following a rigid curriculum was sometimes required and my challenge was to make the students excited by the information I had to deliver thus creating a productive environment.

Clear communication was always required as was the ability to tune into the energy from the students, be aware of their body language, and be able to inject humour or serious information depending on the response of the attendees.

Lecturing in front of numbers between 20 and 400 students required me to present in a relaxed and informative manner whilst communicating the point in an educational and expressive way whether in English or in a foreign language.

Follow-up de-briefs or presentations were an important aspect of the courses I gave. I created a platform for the student to present his/her ideas which included constructive feedback and follow-up work suggestions, to improve their skill levels at producing similar projects at a later date.

Some students I have taught and mentored are working as successful Theatre/Film Practitioners all over the world.
